Under the supervision of the Shop Foreman and Service Manager, the Journeyman Heavy Equipment Technician will be required to perform diagnoses and repairs in all areas of on-highway vehicles (including both towed and self-propelled).

Maintenance & Repair of Vehicles & Equipment May Include:

- Internal combustion engines and components, both stationary and mobile
- On-highway vehicles, commonly called trucks and buses
- Towed on-highway and off-highway vehicles, commonly called trailers

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Journeyman Heavy Equipment Technician performs some or all of the following duties:

- Inspection, maintenance, troubleshooting, overhaul and repair of various components of a variety of heavy duty trucks equipped with diesel engines and automatic or manual transmissions.
- Requisition parts, materials and equipment as needed
- Complete detailed, clear and concise work orders
- Assist Shop Foreman and other technicians in checking and diagnosing mechanical faults of incoming trucks
- Maintain order, cleanliness, work output and safe working conditions in own work area
- Comply with Company Health & Safety Program, Occupational Health & Safety Legislation and any other municipal, provincial or federal legislation as it applies to this dealership.
- Communicates with service advisor immediately if additional work is needed, if work outlined is not needed, or if repairs cannot be completed within the promised time.
- Communicates with parts department efficiently to obtain needed parts. Know all the required parts that will be needed to complete the job assigned. Work with the parts department and their staff to best serve the customer.
- Road test vehicles when required or refer to the designated test technician.
- Participates in company and manufacturer-sponsored training programs, schools, and events.
- Supervises work of any apprentice technicians.
- Reports machinery defects or malfunctions to supervisor.
- Keeps shop area neat, clean and safe. Reports any safety concerns to the Shop Foreman immediately
- Understands, keeps abreast of, and complies with federal, provincial, and local regulations, such as hazardous waste disposal, etc.
